ON ELECTION DAY

On the big day, volunteers are needed for the following tasks:

At the Polls (for these items please note your preferred ward/precinct which is likely to be your own voting precinct)

- Poll Watching (recording which Warren supporters have voted and ensuring that this information is entered online so that we can follow up with those who have not voted). We ideally want at least 2 people per shift per precinct—one to listen and record votes and another with a smartphone or 3G Tablet to enter data using www.VANpollwatcher.com. Shifts are 6:30-10:00 AM, 10:00-1:00, 1:00 4:00 and 4:00 to 6:30 plus a "Closer" shift which require being available from 7:30 to 8:30; closer is responsible for reporting results. Note the shifts may differ from previous sign up forms. If we do not get a full complement of data entry people, we will have runners taking completed sheets to the staging area for data entry there. If you want to help at the polls, let us know whether you have a smartphone or a tablet with 3G service that you can use on election day and can help with data entry.
- **Voter Protection** volunteers with legal training (lawyers, paralegals, law students) who can counter any voter suppression efforts by the opposition.
- Poll Dressing Holding signs at the polls.

Around Malden:

- Canvassing Going door to door, contacting supporters who have not yet voted.
- **Phone Calling** Calling supporters who have not yet voted.
- **Providing Rides** Taking voters to the polls or transporting canvassers to their locations.
- Helping out at our Malden GOTV Staging Area (Laborers Local 22 at 35 Highland Avenue) with all kinds of tasks including hospitality, data entry and reporting, tech troubleshooting, and general coordination.
